Seeking special education teacher to lead academic portion of social skills summer camp for special needs kids. Responsibilities include: administrative duties, assessments, creating lesson plans, individual tutoring, leading support staff, interacting with parents, writing reports, and behavior management.

Teacher will assess each child during first 2 days in writing, reading, and math. Then create individual and group lessons. Teachers direct counselors for individual and group lessons. Teacher will have mid-camp parent telephone update and write final academic progress report.

Must provide own assessment and teaching materials and be licensed to teach special education in NY with no less than 1 year experience leading your own special education classroom. Experience with summer camp is preferred.

Position offers the opportunity to gain hands-on clinical experience with children with various social-emotional difficulties. This is an excellent position for someone who has lots of energy, enjoys working with children, can multi-task well, enjoys being part of a team, and plans to have a career with special needs children.

Prep time is the week before camp starts from 6/25 - 6/29 from 9am-5pm at the program location (805 Columbus Ave / 100th St, Manhattan). The exact days/times are flexible. Need to meet staff, set up classroom and review files.

Camp work hours will be 7/2 – 8/10, Mon-Thurs, 9am-12. Teaching time is about 9:30-11:30. Preparation and clean-up is 9-9:30 and 11:30-12.

Compensation is an hourly rate based on experience. No benefits included.
