



2017 CHAPERON POSITION

Seeking graduate or college level student professionals interested in working with children with mild special needs (i.e., ADHD, ASD, Anxiety, and Learning Disabilities) ages 4-12.

Responsibilities include: supervising children's transportation to/from the program location. Applicant must have strong organizational and interpersonal skills. Experience with ABA or behavioral modification and summer camp is preferred.

Position offers the opportunity to gain hands-on clinical experience with children with various social-emotional difficulties and training in behavior modification.

Work hours are 6 weeks, from 7/5 – 8/11, Mon-Fri, for about 1 hour in the morning (8am) and 1 hour in the afternoon (4pm). Pickup and drop-off times will depend on location, child's age and number of kids. More details below.

Compensation is below. Must be available if needed for the full 6 weeks. No benefits. Reimbursement is provided for fares for trips with the children. Chaperons track their trips and are paid bi-weekly. Travel reimbursements are at the end of the summer.

3 Types of chaperones:

1. **Forest Hills Queens, Subway** – the chaperon meets all children at 8am at 71 Ave Subway station in Forest Hills Queens and rides subway to the program location, arriving at 8:45. The chaperon then takes the campers ages 7-12 at 4:45 from program location back to Forest Hills by 5:45. Kids ages 5-6 leave camp at 3:15pm. On Friday, the trip home is at 3:30 for all ages. There are usually 3 chaperones for 6 kids. Pay is \$30 per one way trip.
2. **Park Slope Brooklyn, Subway** - meet children at 8am at Grand Army Plaza Subway station in Park Slope Brooklyn and ride subway to location, arriving at 8:45. Chaperon meets children ages 7-12 again at 4:45 at program location to bring them back to Brooklyn by 5:45. Kids ages 5-6 leave camp at 3:15pm. On Friday, the trip home is at 3:30 for all ages. There are usually 3 chaperones for 6 kids. Pay is \$30 per one way trip.
3. **Manhattan Home Pick Up** – pick up the camper at his/her home in Manhattan; ride public transportation. Then take the camper home at 3:15pm (if age 5-6), 4:45 (if age 7-12), or 3:30 if Friday. Parents may choose to use taxi (at their cost). Pay is \$25 per one way trip.
