2017 STAFF COUNSELOR POSITION

Seeking graduate or college level student professionals with a strong desire to work with special needs children (e.g., ADHD, ASD, Anxiety, Learning Disabilities) ages 4-12 for a social skills summer treatment program in Manhattan.

Responsibilities include: administrative tasks, leading sports and activities, academic tutoring, tracking progress on Daily Report Cards, social skills training, and behavior management. Applicants must have strong organizational and interpersonal skills. Experience with ABA or behavioral modification, social skills and summer camp is preferred.

Position offers the opportunity to gain hands-on clinical experience with children with various social-emotional difficulties and training in behavior modification. This is an excellent position for someone who has lots of energy, enjoys working with children, enjoys sports and group activities, can multi-task well, and plans to have a career with special needs children.

Mandatory paid training is the week before camp starts from 6/26 – 6/30 from 9am-5pm at program location (805 Columbus Ave / 100th St, Manhattan).

Camp work hours are 7/5 – 8/11, Mon-Fri, 8:30am-5:15pm.

Compensation is \$3,138.00 for 7 weeks (including 1 week of training). No benefits included. Payroll is done bi-weekly.

If interested, please complete online application and follow the application directions. The hiring process consists of an initial 10-minute phone interview, followed by a group interview (which includes a short individual interview). Applicants are required to attend one of the group interviews which are posted online.

Must provide recent physical or medical clearance from a licensed physician prior to training start date.
