2019 CHAPERON POSITION

Seeking graduate or college level student professionals interested in working with children with mild special needs (i.e., ADHD, ASD, Anxiety, and Learning Disabilities) ages 5-12.

Responsibilities include: supervising children's transportation to/from the program location. Applicant must have strong organizational and interpersonal skills. Experience with ABA or behavioral modification and summer camp is preferred.

Position offers the opportunity to gain hands-on clinical experience with children with various social-emotional difficulties and training in behavior modification.

Work hours are 4-6 week assignments, from 7/1 – 8/9, Mon-Thurs, for up to 1 hour in the morning (8-9am) and 1 hour in the afternoon (4:45-5:45pm). Camp starts at 9am and ends at 3:30pm on Fridays. Exact pickup and drop-off times will depend on the child's home address.

The chaperon picks up the camper at his/her home within a 1 hour radius of camp location and takes public transportation back to camp. The chaperon then returns to camp to bring the camper back home.

Compensation is \$60 per day for both trips. Must be available if needed for the full 6 weeks. No benefits. Reimbursement is provided for fares for trips with the children. Chaperons track their trips and are paid bi-weekly. Travel reimbursements are at the end of the summer.

If interested, please complete online application and follow the application directions. The hiring process consists of an initial 10-minute phone interview, followed by an in person interview.

Complete application will require CV/resume and 2 letters of recommendation.

Must provide recent physical or medical clearance from a licensed physician prior to training start date.
